

## Scan more intelligently with Microform

In this context, the scanner specialists from Waiblingen, near Stuttgart, Germany, will, together with the service and sales partner, G.O.S. Gesellschaft für Optische Speichersysteme mbH from Rehlingen-Siersburg situated on the German-French border, be using this year's DMS-Expo in Essen to present capture solutions that allow documents to be fully processed in a single system.

The centerpiece of this presentation will be the high-performance scanners from Microform, combined with **detection and classification technologies from Docutec AG** headquartered in Aachen, Germany. In the course of the process, the documents are – immediately on the heels of production-oriented scanning – classified according to document type and in this way assigned for predefined subsequent processing functions. Likewise, data can be extracted directly – such as when processing incoming mail or archived documents that require evaluation – and the information gathered transferred directly to IT systems for further processing. It is also possible to import images from external sources with this system.

These flexible processes are supported by **Microform's Smart Color Detection**. This function combines intelligent color detection with automated color control. Selected color codes that can be detected by the unit during scanning indicate to the system what steps are necessary for further processing. This eliminates complex sorting and preparatory work as well as cost-intensive patch code sheets.

"Together with strong partners, we are constantly working on and improving our archiving solutions, in full accord with our own **Best Image Quality Concept**", Klinke emphasizes. In this way, he explains, Microform is living up to its own aspiration to offer users versatile, intelligent and tailor-made capturing solutions.
