With this high level of equipment, the MF S 385 offers such a high degree of stability and flexibility that even larger production volumes can't bring it to its knees.

The camera system built into the MF S 385 is likewise of such high quality that the unit produces results that are equally as good as those output by Microform's high-end scanners. Two totally new, dustfree encapsulated camera units – comprising Trilinear CCD cameras, combined with high-quality lenses from Rodenstock and specially bloomed (antireflection-coated) optical mirrors – produce outstanding scan results.

It goes without saying that the MF S 385 has also been designed in line with Microform's new **Best Image Quality** concept, a combination of cutting-edge scanner technology and state-of-the-art image management functions. As such, the MF S 385 offers a perfected all-inclusive solution for flexible and production-oriented production.
